- Iowa Code § 216.9 Iowa Civil Rights Act
 - "It is an unfair or discriminatory practice for any educational institution to discriminate on the basis of . . . gender identity . . . in any program or activity."

RELEVANT STATE LAWS (CONTINUED)



- Iowa Code § 280.28
 - "School employees, volunteers, and students shall not engage in harassing or bullying behavior" against students.
 - Harassment and bullying defined
 - Trait or characteristic defined

RELEVANT FEDERAL LAWS



- 20 U.S.C. § 1681 Title IX
 - "No person . . . shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity "
